

LEGISLATIVE UPDATE: The Legislature concluded their special session with no legislation or budget measures passed that were considered anti-RHC. Additional respite funding was approved for Yakima Valley School and other RHCs. Action DD lobbyist, Rick Jensen, and his team, are well respected and well connected in our Washington State political system.

RESEARCH PROJECT UPDATE: Your FOR board is exploring ways to implement the research project initiatives presented by Teresa Dean at our last general membership meeting. The next steps involve appointing a Committee head to oversee the various research activities necessary to carry out this project. The committee head would then submit a plan to identify and hire or appoint one or more researchers or a research firm to carry out the first phases of a Systematic Research Review (SRR). Please contact me or a board member if you are interested and qualified to provide your time and expertise to this important project. RHC critics have volumes of biased research they reference as a reason to shut down RHCs. This project will help scientifically debunk these bogus studies that essentially compare Apples to Oranges.

RAINIER ART CENTER OPEN HOUSE: An Open House will be held at the Rainier Arts Center immediately following the next FOR general membership meeting in September. Come see art projects sponsored by the Pierce County Arts commission and other art works that residents have created. Rainier staff members have a number of additional projects and activities in the works such as the glass kiln (sponsored by a Grant from the Pierce County Arts commission) an environmentally designed rain garden, and a Mandela display of art works that will be located adjacent to an existing arts project located in the middle of the Rainier School campus.
